JIMS – IIC organised a session about “How to plan for start-up: Legal & Ethical Steps” on 12th may 2022. The Speaker of the day Guy Kawasaki, All Top Co-founder shared his valuable guidance on this topic. Thus, Speaker listed lots of things that we need to keep in mind before starting a start-up which includes recognising the unique idea, secondly doing proper research and analysis and thirdly setting a business plan and in last but not the least expansion of Market. One must be aware of all these things before starting a start-up. Then, the speaker talked about the types of entities which one should be aware of before starting a business or start-up. The types of entities included Proprietorship, Partnership, Limited Liability Partnership (LLP) etc. After types of entities, the speaker educated the audience about the Mandatory and Optional requirements for start-up. ECON QUEST

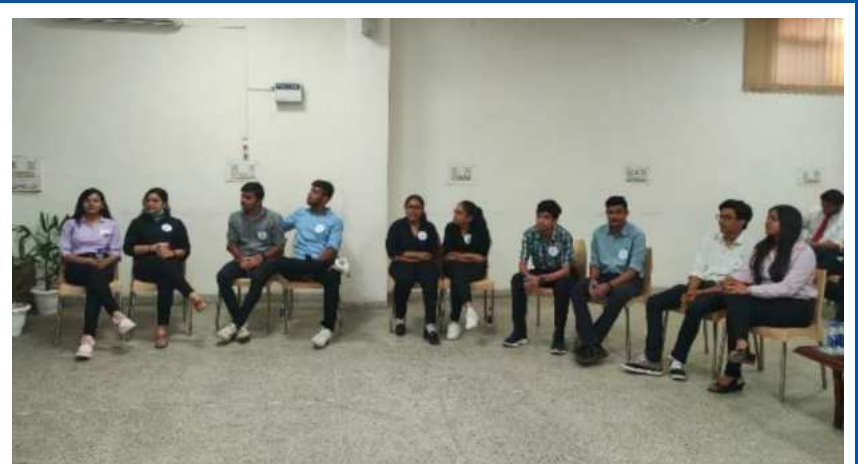

GUEST SESSION ON CORPORATE EXPECTATIONS

The Institution's Innovation Council, JIMS Rohini Sector-5 organized a workshop on PROTOTYPE- PROCESS DESIGN AND DEVELOPMENT to make the students understand the importance of Prototype-design and development model/process on 21st May 2022. Students learned to use the Product Design and Development Process, as a means to manage the development of an idea from concept through to production. Also demonstrate, apply, explain, and recognize basic family of materials used in soft-goods and hard-goods, including sustainable materials and manufacturing processes. At the end, there was an engaging question and answer round and many students also got a view about working in this field.

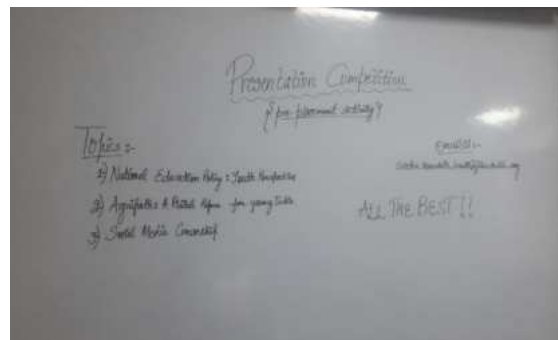
The participants were contended and happy with the knowledge shared.

The competition was open to all the students of 1st year. Students were asked to participate in a team of two students.



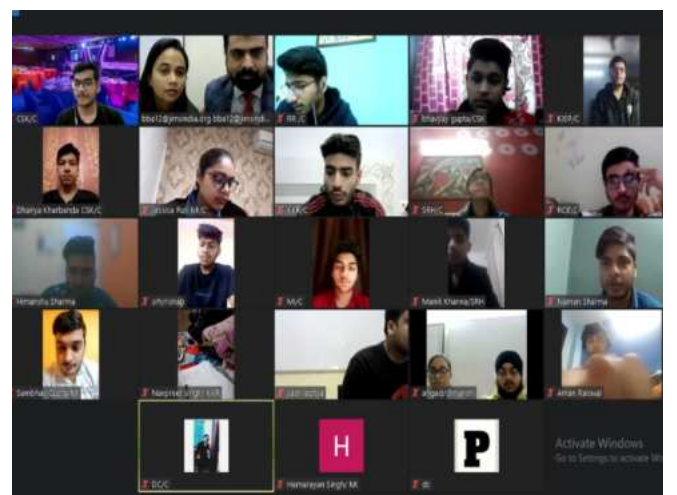
INVESTOMANIA: A SHORT TALK ON STOCK MARKET

16 teams participated in the event from GGSIPU affiliated colleges, Delhi University colleges, and some autonomous colleges from Delhi and Uttar Pradesh.

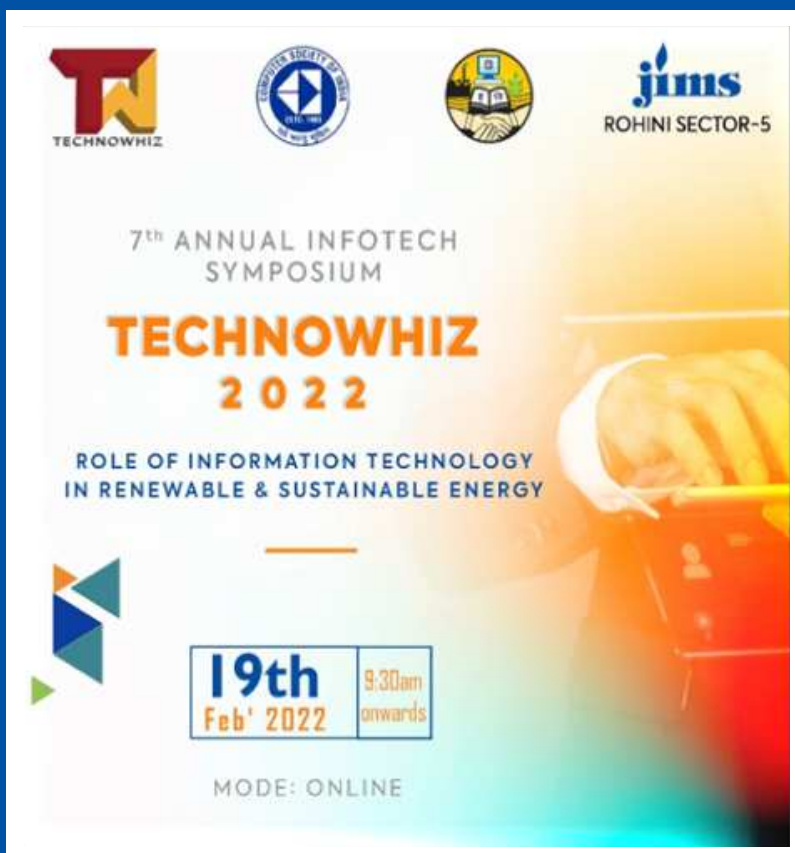
