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**STUDY ABROAD**

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## KNOW IT ALL!

1) Firstly you must decide which country you have to pursue your studies. Some of the countries that are mostly preferred by students are Canada, Australia, London.

2) For doing the management course in abroad you first have to qualify some of the entrance exams. The list of entrance exams is as follows:  
SAT(Scholastic aptitude test)- It is held 7 times a year, generally on the first Saturdays of October, November, December, January, March, May and June.

GMAT(Graduate management admission test)- Candidates can retake the GMAT exam after 16 days time period and candidates cannot exceed 5 GMAT exams within a year and 8 GMAT exams in a lifetime.

IELTS(International English language testing system)- It is held 4 times a month.

TOEFL(Test of English as a foreign language)- It takes place more than 50 times in a year and candidate cannot take it more than once in 12 day period.

3) Students need to get decent scores in these entrance exams to get admission in top universities.

Some of the best colleges with their fee structure in the above mentioned countries are:

(1) Ivey Business School - University of Western Ontario(CANADA)  
MBA Tuition Fees: \$ 88,500 (for International students) + other expenses ranging from \$4050 - \$10455. Average Years Work Experience: 4.8 years

(2) Rotman School Of Management- University Of Toronto(CANADA)  
International Students: 48% MBA Tuition Fees: \$99,710 (for International students) + \$3,300 (University incidental fee & ancillary fees). Average Work Experience: 4.5 years

3) University of Melbourne Business school(AUSTRALIA) Tuition fees for International Students (in USD): \$67,000

4) AGSM at Univ of New South Wales Business school(AUSTRALIA) Tuition fees for International Students (in USD): \$64,000

5) University of Cambridge (UK) Tuition fees for International Students(in USD): \$41,040

6) University of Oxford (UK) Tuition fees for International Students(in USD): \$30,760

Universities or colleges in Canada generally takes GMAT entrance exam into consideration. Universities or colleges in Australia generally takes IELTS entrance exam into consideration. Universities or colleges in the UK generally take GMAT or IELTS entrance exam into consideration.

When students study in abroad the money required to survive there is very high. Students have to take care of their rent, their food, clothing, accessories, their study material and many more things. When a student belongs to a middle-class family their parents can support them to a certain extent thereafter they have to take care of themselves.

When a student is studying in abroad it becomes important for the student to do some part-time job for survival as it is not at all cheap to live abroad. Some of the part-time jobs that they can do are

In Canada, you can go for International Student Advisor: Income: \$1,793-\$2,100 a month, Research Assistant: Income: \$22 an hour.

In Australia, you can go for Immigration Assistant: Income: \$14-\$16 an hour, Speaking examiner: Income: \$51 an hour.

In the UK you can go for Part-time Enrolment Coordinator: Income: £8 per hour, Warehouse Assistant, Order picker: Income:£ 8.75-£ 9.00 an hour.
