Indian Finance minister Nirmala Sitharaman held a review meeting with the heads of all leading banks and finance companies through video conferencing on 4th Sep to review their preparedness for restructuring loans of borrowers that have come under stress related to Covid-19. She tells to banks that Covid-related distress must not

impact the lenders' assessment of their credit-worthiness.

In the meeting, According to banks, loans in hospitality, toll road projects and retail malls are facing maximum stress and some may require deep restructuring.

In a statement issued after the meeting, the government said

that lenders have been advised to try and extend the maximum possible relief to borrowers before the festive season.

Talking about Joe Biden economic policies he mostly talks in favor of India as compared to Trump. According to bidden manifesto, he will be-

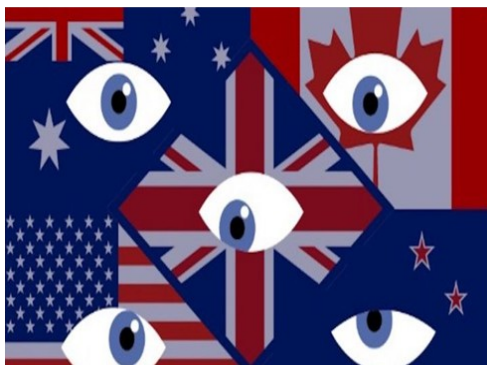
stow visa relaxation to Indian workers but he is also against the implementation of article 370 in Kashmir.

Former England All-Rounder David Capel Dies

Ex-England all-rounder David Capel has died aged 57 following a long illness, his former country Northamptonshire announced on Wednesday.

Capel, who played 15 Tests and 23 one-day internationals between 1987 and 1990, was diagnosed with a brain tumor in 2018. The club said on their Twitter account: "It is with incredibly heavy hearts that we announce the death of former Northamptonshire and England great David Capel at the age of 57."

Capel, who was one of a number of all-rounder's burdened with the tag of being the "new Ian Botham", made his Test

debut against Pakistan in 1987, scoring a half-century.

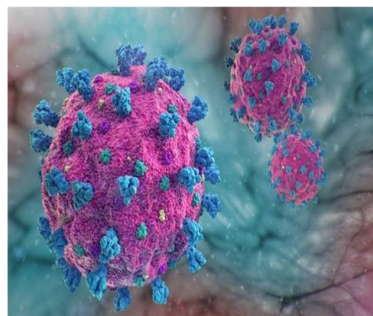
He was also part of the England team that produced a huge shock by beating the powerful West Indies in Jamaica in 1990. Capel scored 374 Test runs at an average of 15.58, with a highest score of 98 against Pakistan in Karachi in 1987, and took 21 wickets at 50.66 with his medium pace.

The Recognition

The Judgment

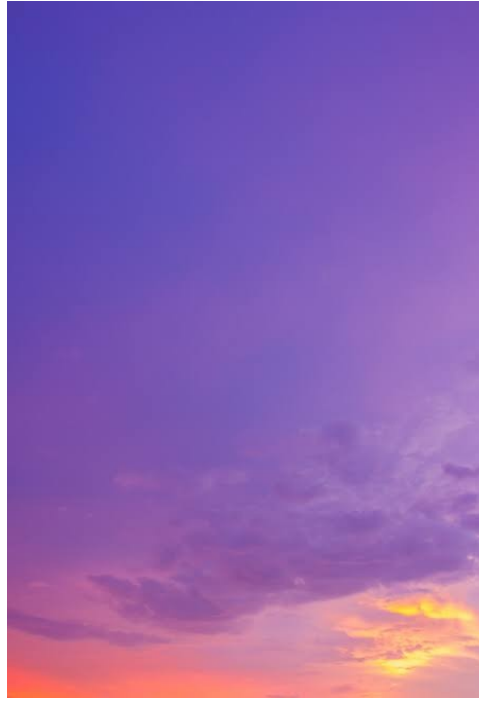
Winter falls,

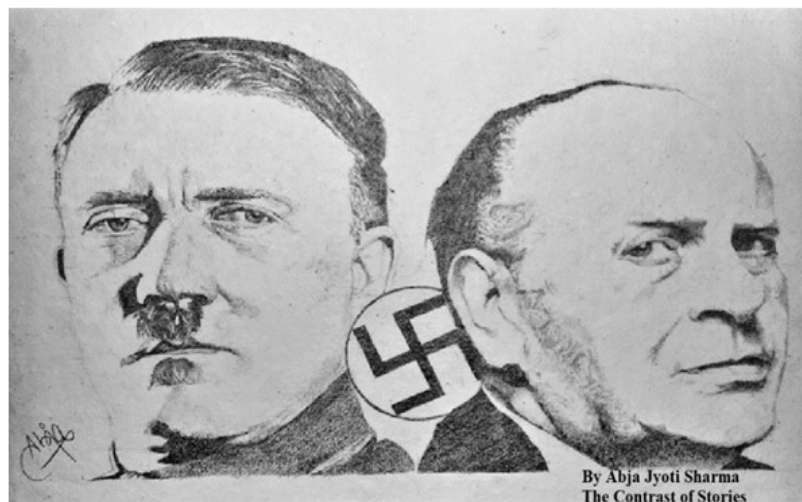

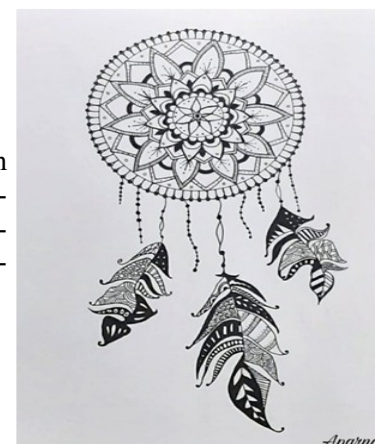
Mandala Art

symbolizing the notion that life is. Making mandalas increases our concentration power and ability to think.

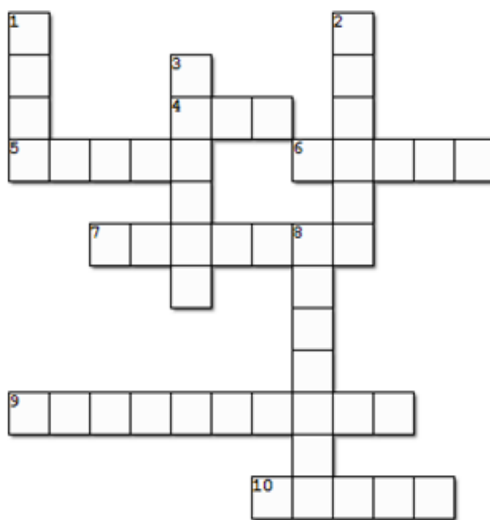
