

#### Not just pent-up demand that is reviving economy

Finance Minister Nirmala Sitharaman on Friday said the economy reflating at a rate faster than previously expected is not just due to pent up demand but also because of additional demand coming in, and the recovery will sustain.


Without delving into the budget she will present in two months, she said the government and the Reserve Bank are coordinating for a quicker economic recovery.

## Maharashtra accounts for the greatest number of active COVID-19 cases, deaths in country

New Delhi: Maharashtra accounts for the highest number of both 86,612 active COVID-19 cases and 47,472 fatalities in the country, according to the latest Union health ministry data on Friday.

In terms of active cases, Maharashtra is followed by Kerala with 61,342 cases and Delhi with 29,120 cases. As far as the number of fatalities is concerned, Maharashtra is followed by Karnataka (11,821) and Delhi (9,424).

Maharashtra also accounts for the highest number of recoveries so far which is over 17 lakhs. It is followed by Andhra Pradesh (8,56,320) and Karnataka (8,52,584).



## Govt proposes next meeting on December 9; seeks time from farmer unions for concrete proposal

The government on Saturday proposed to hold another meeting on December 9 with representatives of protesting farmers, as their fifth round of talks ended in a deadlock with the farmers' group going on a 'maun vrat' (vow of silence) seeking a clear 'yes or no' answer to their demand of repealing three farm laws.

#### Supply-side issues hurting inflation, says Reserve Bank of India Deputy Governor Patra

RBI Deputy Governor Michael Patra on Friday said supplyside issues, including profit maximisation at retailers' end, are hurting the inflation situation, which has breached the central bank's comfort level in the past few months. There is a window for cooling off in prices presented by the softness in vegetable prices in winters and arrivals of the kharif or summer crop, Patra said affirming that the RBI is watchful of the demand-side issues.

## Joe Biden, New president of America asked for 100 day of wearing mask as his first Act.

Joe Biden, New president of America said that he will ask Americans to commit to 100 days of wearing masks as one of his first acts as president, stopping just short of the nationwide mandate he's pushed before to stop the spread of the coronavirus. The president-elect has frequently emphasized mask-wearing as a "patriotic duty" and during the campaign floated the idea of instituting a nationwide mask mandate, which he later acknowledged would be beyond the ability of the president to enforce.



#### The first Black House foreign affairs chairman, Congressman Gregory Meeks

Gregory Meeks, a strong supporter of the India-US relationship, was elected as the next chairman of the powerful House Foreign Affairs Committee on Thursday 3rd December. He became the first African-American to head the Congressional committee that plays an influential role in shaping the foreign policy of the US.

In an interview, Meeks said that "The committee under the next Congress will preside over an historic shift in US foreign policy, and there is no shortage of work ahead of us. Not only will we need to re-engage with a world that has felt the marked absence of US global leadership, but we must also rethink traditional approaches to foreign policy,".

#### First ODI postponed after SA player tests positive for Covid-19

The first One-day International cricket match between South Africa and England has been postponed to Sunday because a player from the Proteas team was tested positive for COVID-19. The decision was taken by both the England Cricket Board as well as the home board, Cricket South Africa.

The amended tour dates are as follows:

Sunday, December 6, 2020 - 1st ODI, Paarl (day match)

Monday, December 7, 2020 - 2nd ODI, Cape Town (day-night match)

Wednesday, December 9, 2020 - 3rd ODI, Cape Town (day-night match).





#### Amazon to turn Alexa into chatbot.

Users of Alexa may get to use it as a chatbot, with which they can chat and talk. Amazon is testing typing functionality for Alexa on iOS devices which will allow users to send messages to Alexa rather than using voice, especially in situations like when people are in a public place or in a meeting where voice command is awkward. Amazon spokesperson quoted 'Type with Alexa' will allow you to interact with Alexa without using voice, "meaning everything you can currently say to Alexa can now also be typed using your Alexa mobile app". It will further help people using Alexa efficiently and also will have new experience.




