

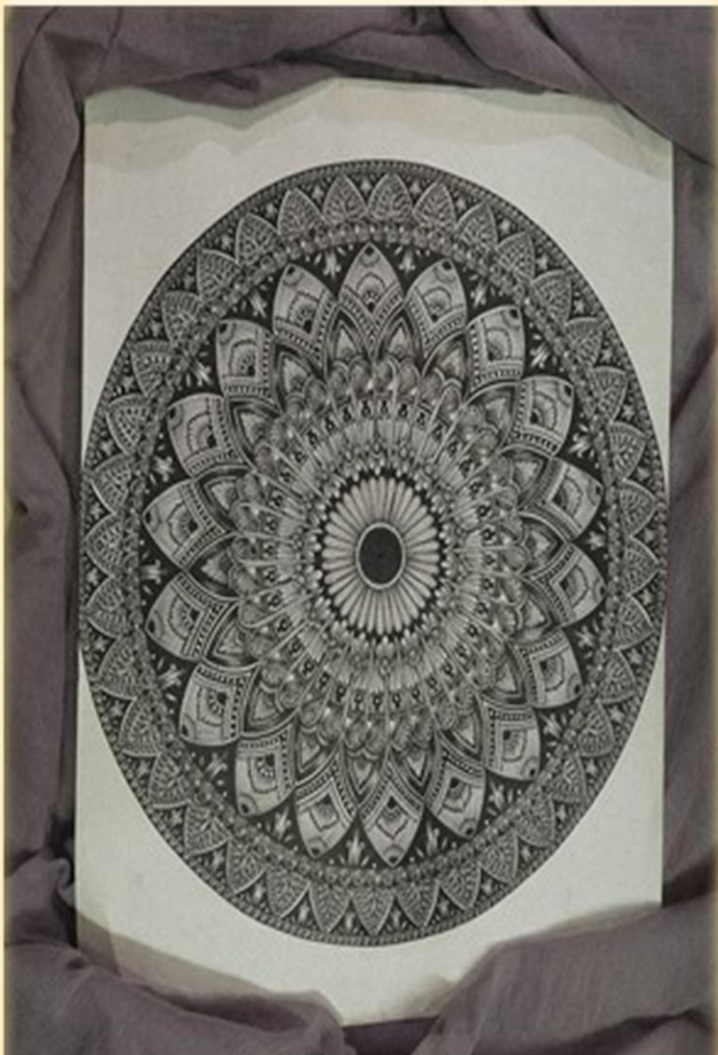

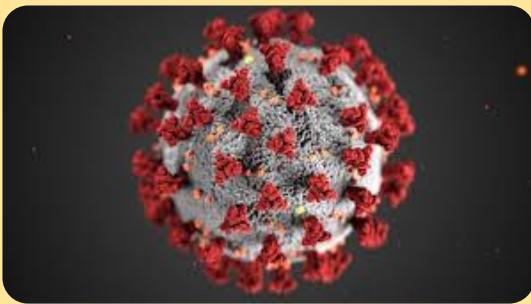


## India's first Driverless Metro to run in Delhi

India's first 'Driverless' train will roll out across the national capital adjoining cities such as Noida, Gurugram, Faridabad, Ghaziabad & Bahadurgarh This driverless train will have six coaches along with several advanced features and will run to the 38 km long line 8 or Magenta line of the Delhi Metro

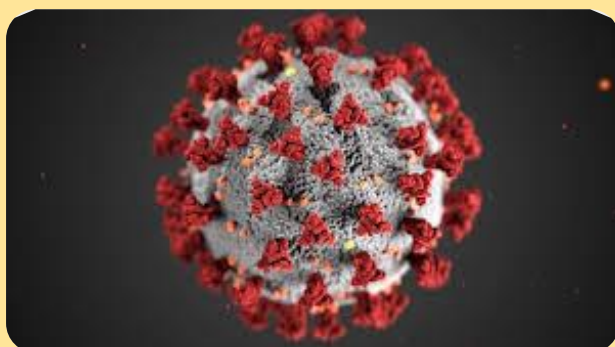


**Shares at record high on boost from Reliance, banking stocks**



## UK-EU Trade deal agreement

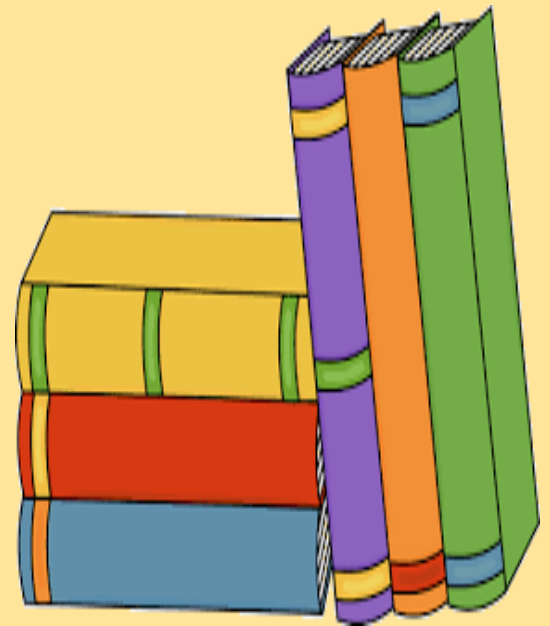

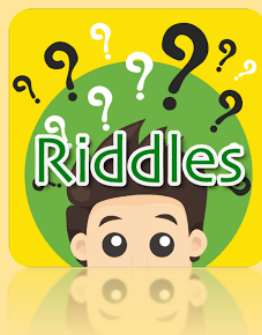
