

John Maxwell, helps leaders gain the ability and willingness to make leadership changes that will positively enhance their organizational and personal growth. He writes that every advance you make as a leader will require a leadershift that changes the way you think, act, and lead. He states that If you want to be an effective leader, you must leadershift.

The author focuses on how you can make a continual shift from action to reflection. He presents questions and challenges and the leadershifts presented in this book will take you from being a good leader to becoming a better one. He further writes that if you try to make some small shift in that direction every day, you can and will reach your leadership potential.

The first chapter mentions seven things that leader must do to leadershift successfully and embracing these practices daily will help in encounter every leadershift situation with flexibility and confidence.

In rest of the book the author elaborates on 11 leadershifts that he has practiced and helped him in gaining new leadership territory and inward growth.



SOLOIST TO CONDUCTOR (The Focus Shift)

In this leadershift of team building author emphasis on five major aspects, i.e., going slower so you can go farther, recognizing that you need others, making the effort to understand others, wanting others to shine than you do and helping others to become better everyday.

GOALS TO GROWTH (The Personal Development Shift)

How to focus on growth more than the small goals. He put together nine major points in this leadershift:

- Focus on growth inward
- Grow in few vital things (REAL:
 R-Relationship, E-Equipping, A-Attitude,
 L- Leadership)
- Grow without a finish line
- Embrace Change
- Adopt a teachable spirit
- Make your love for learning greater than your fear of failure
- Develop relationship with other growing people
- Develop greater humility
- Embrace layered learning

PERKS TO PRICE (The Cost Shift)

The author shared his experience how he shifted from being focused on what he can receive as a leader (the perks) to what he can give as a leader (the price). He discussed three qualities that every leader should have to shift from perks to price:

- Reality-Leaders recognize that everything worthwhile is Uphill
- Example-Leaders acknowledge they must climb the hill first
- Consistency-Leaders understand they never get to stop climbing

PLEASING PEOPLE TO CHALLENGING PEOPLE (The Relationship Shift)

The leader has to do what's right for the people and organization ahead of what feels right. He emphasized on doing seven things to make this shift:

- Change your expectations toward leadership
- Value people as much as you value yourself
- Work to establish expectations up front
- Ask yourself the hard questions before any potentially difficult conversation
- When a tough conversation is needed, do it right
- Understand the 25-50-25 principle
- Balance care with Candor

MAINTAINING TO CREATING (The Abundance Shift)

If the leader wants to shift from maintaining to creating in their life and leadership than they need to take their crayons back. Here's how:

- Build a creative culture
- Make everything better
- Make plans but look for options
- Place high value on ideas
- · Seek out and listen to different voices
- Take risks
- Live on the other side of "Yes"

LADDER CLIMBING TO LADDER BUILDING (The Reproduction Shift)

If the leader wants to shift from maintaining to creating in their life and leadership than they need to take their crayons back. Here's how:

- Build a creative culture
- Make everything better
- Make plans but look for options
- Place high value on ideas
- Seek out and listen to different voices
- Take risks
- Live on the other side of "Yes"

DIRECTING TO CONNECTING (The Communication Shift)

The author stresses on finding ways to over-come the challenge of connecting and finding common ground. He highlighted seven qualities that leader must have to achieve this communication shift:

- Humility-Let people know you need them
- Curiosity- Ask people questions
- Effort- Go out of your way to connect with people
- Trustworthiness- Be someone others can count on
- Generosity- Give first, give continually
- Listening-Open the best door to connecting with people
- Encouragement-Give people Oxygen for their soul

TEAM UNIFORMITY TO TEAM DIVERSITY (The Communication Shift)

A team is a small number of people with complementary skills who are committed to a common purpose, set of performance goals, and approach for which they hold themselves mutually accountable". He put across three advantages of diverse team:

- Diverse teams fill in the knowledge gap
- Diverse teams fill in the perspective gap
- Diverse teams fill in the experience gap

POSITIONAL AUTHORITY TO MORAL AUTHORITY (The Influence Shift)

Author believes that anyone can pursue moral authority and develop greater influence by developing in following four areas:

- Competence-The ability to lead well
- Courage- Moving forward in the face of fear
- Consistency- Doing well all the time, not just sometimes
- Character- Being bigger on the inside than outside (Integrity, Authenticity, Humility, Love)

TRAINED LEADERS TO TRANSFORMATIONAL LEADERS (The Impact Shift)

Author has studied transformational movements and the people who led them. He identifies five actions common to all of them which can help leaders to impact shift from trained leader to transformational leaders:

- Possess a clear picture of what transformational leaders do
- Focus on your own transformation before leading others to it
- Take positive action based on your internal changes
- Create an environment that promotes positive change
- Commit to making difference with others in your community

CAREER TO CALLING (The Passion Shift)

In this leadershift author emphasizes on converting career to passion. He wants to help leaders in understanding calling so that they can find theirs. He identifies eight qualities of calling:

- Your calling matches who you are
- Your calling taps into your passion
- Your calling is important to you, but it's not about you
- Your calling is bigger than you
- Your calling changes your perspective
- Your calling gives you purpose
- Your calling helps you to overcome obstacles
- Your calling brings fulfillment
