A Nostalgic Journey: My Time at Jagan Institute of Management Studies (JIMS)

I had the privilege of joining Jagan Institute of Management Studies (JIMS) in 1995, a pivotal time in India's history, post the liberalization of the Indian economy. This was an era when owning a mobile phone and a Maruti car were considered extreme luxuries. The winds of change were sweeping across the nation, and we, as a fresh batch of students, were excited to be part of it.

Our class back then consisted of 60 students, with a fair representation of both genders, a rare and progressive sight in those times. Going beyond science

If ChatGPT was a philosopher, it would probably throw a very different answer about ‘biggest threats to the sustainable world’.


The root cause of all problems is ignorance

1. Compulsive overconsumption

The global material footprint has surged dramatically,

rising from 43 billion metric tons in 1990 to 92 billion metric tons by 2017—a staggering 113% increase since 1990 and 70% since 2000. This upward trend is accelerating, with projections estimating a rise to 190 billion metric tons by 2060. Alarmingly, the rate of natural resource extraction outpaces both population growth and economic output, revealing a persistent and unsustainable link between resource consumption, population expansion, and GDP growth. Decoupling these trends remains a critical challenge for global sustainability.

Population, material footprint and GDP growth index, 2000–2017 (baseline 2000=100)





2. A skewed world order

The urban and affluent segments of society are not just significant contributors but arguably the primary drivers of unsustainability. This is a self-inflicted crisis, and the solutions we pursue often risk amplifying the problem.

Material footprint per capita has risen alarmingly—from 8.1 metric tons in 1990 to 12.2 metric tons in 2017, marking a 50% increase. High-income countries lead this overconsumption with an average material footprint of 27 metric tons per person, 60% higher than upper-middle-income nations (17 metric tons) and over 13 times that of low-income countries (2 metric tons). This disparity underscores the disproportionate burden the wealthy impose on global resources, threatening the planet's sustainability.

Lessons from philosophy for a sustainable world

If there's one easy formula to drive sustainability, the world would be a much better place by now. But that's not the case. What do we have instead are philosophical school of thoughts, and some age old wisdom about interaction between human and nature.

One such best practice – which I strongly advocate – is THE ART OF DOING NOTHING.

While it sounds as easy as ABC, even in its simplest form, it's easy to confuse and even easier to misinterpret, distort or completely dilute the meaning. In a world dominated and hugely inclined towards hustle culture, *Idleness is the anti-hero, if not the antagonist.*

For centuries, idleness and laziness have been labeled as vices. Society expects constant labor and self-improvement, treating any departure from these pursuits as either a luxury or a moral failing. Bertrand Russell's famous praise of idleness often gets dismissed as an aristocratic ideal, seemingly unattainable for those striving to make ends meet.

However, idleness is more than mere indulgence—it is a perspective, a process, and not the entirety of life. In its simplicity, idleness offers liberation from the constraints imposed by societal expectations, whether rooted in philosophy or capitalism. It redefines what it means to be human, inviting reflection and freedom beyond the ceaseless demands of productivity.

Demystifying NIKSEN

Niksen is a Dutch verb which means "doing nothing", which can be roughly translated as "nixing". This is the art of doing nothing on purpose. It is the **opposite of mindfulness**, where you're actively trying to be present in the moment and aware of your surroundings. It's easier said than done. Doing nothing, in the true sense of the word, can be overwhelming if you attempt to do too much nothing at once.

How Niksen is the starting point for a sustainable world?

Nothing can work – not even science – unless we restrain the almost unavoidable urge for instant DOPAMINE.

Idleness = Less consumption = More moderation

Idleness can result in moderate consumption through various mechanisms and mindsets:

Mindful Reflection

Idleness often involves moments of reflection and contemplation. During these periods, individuals may consider the true value of their consumption habits. They may realize that material possessions and excessive consumption don't necessarily lead to lasting happiness or fulfillment.

Reduced Impulse Buying

People who practice idleness may be less susceptible to impulse buying. Instead of making hasty purchasing decisions, they take the time to think about whether they genuinely need a product or if it aligns with their values and priorities.

Focus on Experiences
